With this chart, we endeavour only to inform you on the "differences" and options available when selecting the appropriate fertiliser for your particular application.

The difference between Controlled Release Fertilisers and Slow Release Fertilisers

Controlled Release Fertilisers are prills of fertiliser encapsulated in a polymer coating. The polymer coating controls the rate of release by allowing the fertiliser to pass through the coating according to the media temperature and media moisture content. **Controlled Release Fertilisers** are efficient, economical and minimize nutrient loss and run off.

Slow Release Fertilisers work by being slightly soluble. The solubility of the product and media moisture content control the release rate. As a result, even though climatic conditions may not be conducive to growing, **Slow Release Fertilisers** will continue to release when the growing media contains enough moisture.
